

As always, remind your students to be safe upon entering the school and at dismissal time, by using these general safety rules:
Walking and bike riding should be on the sidewalk, not in the roadways.
No pushing or rough housing, this includes no tree or wall climbing.
In the morning—come straight to school, at dismissal—go straight home.

Dismissal Procedure!!!



Your child's safety is always first on our list.
Congested hallways can be overwhelming to young children. In order to streamline dismissal we will use the exits listed below.

Any student who needs to be picked up in the office prior to dismissal should be picked up before 2:45. This keeps the hallways clear for the lines that students need to make for dismissal (500 students in the hallway—WOW!!!) WHEN STUDENTS ARE RELEASED EARLY FROM SCHOOL FOR ANY REASON, IT IS REFLECTED ON THEIR ATTENDANCE. (Children should only be getting picked up if they have an appointment.)

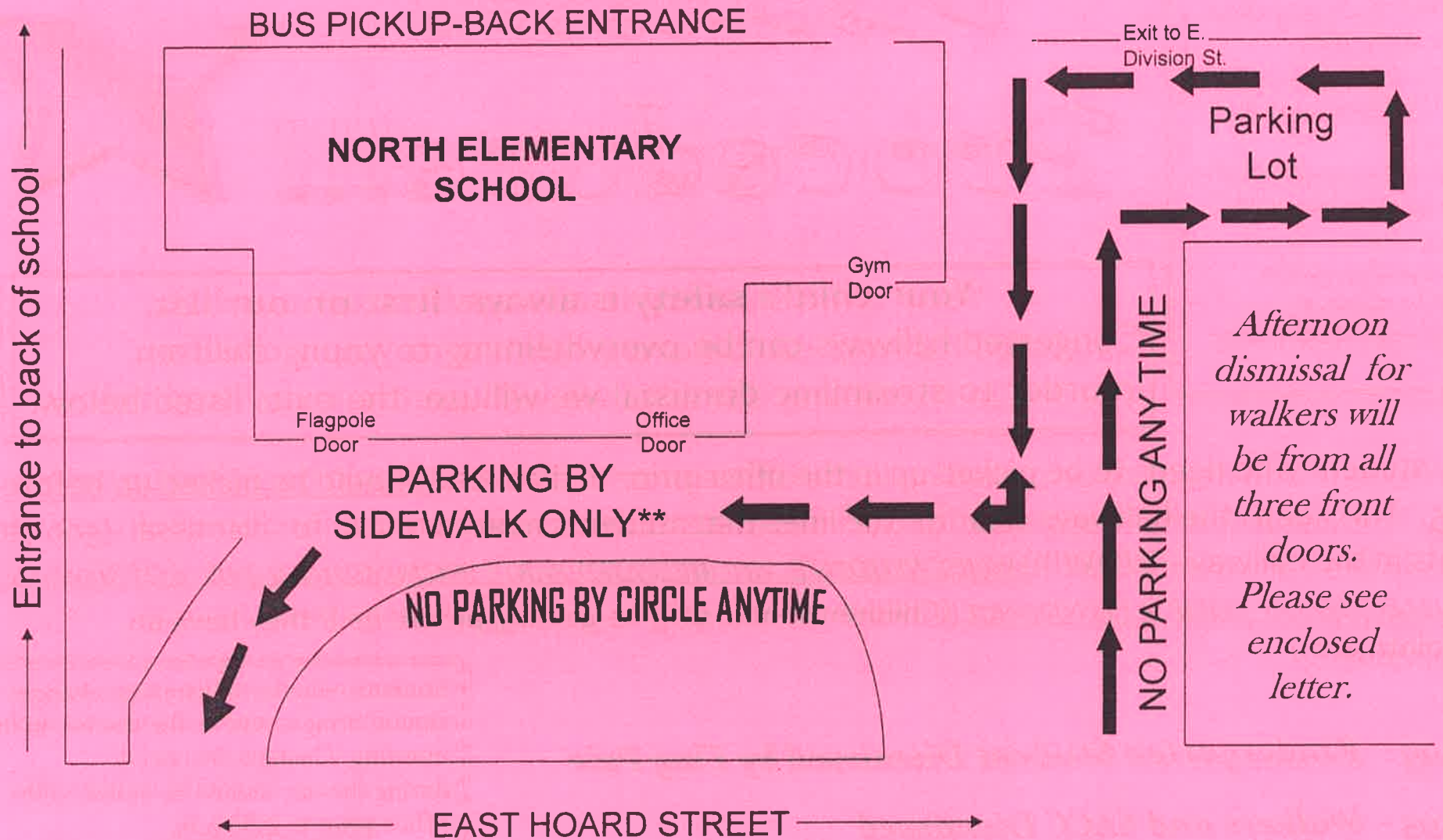
