

Welcome to Case Middle School

We are looking forward to a great year! Here are a couple of things to help you have a successful year at Case Middle School.

- Backpacks are only to be used to and from school. We do not allow our students to carry a backpack or book bag in the hallways between classes.
- Students that are late to school more than 5 times in a 10 week marking period will receive an after school detention.
- Please remember that as cooler weather approaches we do not allow coats to be worn during the school day. Please be sure to have a sweater or hoodie if you get cold.
- Only clear liquids in clear bottles are allowed. Students bringing in any other type of beverages will be required to dispose of them.
- The school day begins at 7:30 a.m. Students must be in their seats at that time or they will be marked as tardy.
- Students who will be leaving during the school day, must provide the attendance office with a note from their parent/guardian explaining why they will be leaving and at what time.
- Cell phones are not permitted during the school day. Any phones being seen or heard by staff will be confiscated. Students may pick their phone up in the main office after the first offense. Any further offenses will require a parent to come into the office and retrieve the phone.
- There is a phone available for student use in the main office. Students may use the phone before and after school, during study halls, lunch and independent reading.
- Students must have their planner. Your planner will allow you to travel outside the classroom. It is also a helpful tool to keep track of assignments and important dates. If you should lose your planner, a new one may be purchased for \$5 from the main office.
- If parents/guardians need to get a message to their child please call before 2:00 p.m. Messages left after 2:00 p.m. cannot be guaranteed to reach the student before dismissal.
- Please be sure to read over our Code of Conduct Policy in your planner. This information includes our dress code and discipline policies. Students not following our dress code may be required to call home for a change of clothing.
