

# What happens when.....

## We have a two hour delay???

- The start of school is delayed by two hours—10:30 am will be the start of our school day.
- The bus schedule is 2 hours delayed...if the bus normally comes at 7:45 am—the two hour delay time is 9:45 am.
- The doors will open 10:10 am on a 2 hour delay.
- Breakfast will NOT be served.
- The cycle day stays the same.

## There is snow day???

- This includes SACC — SACC is cancelled on this day.
- The cycle day for the snow day moves to the next day.
- The Lunch menu changes—sometimes we have what was planned for lunch on the snow day is served the day we return. Our Food Service Director notifies us when we return to school of the menu update.

## The district decides to close school early???

- At the beginning of the year parents filled out a Snow Day Tips form, which stated what their child's plan will be for an early dismissal. If you want to change that plan, please write a note or come into the main office to revise your child's early dismissal plan.
- SACC does NOT operate when the district closes school early.

## "No After School Activities" is Announced???

- Sometimes the District announces "No After School Activities" which means just that....anything planned for after school is canceled.... EXCEPT SACC!!! In this case, SACC stays open.

## How will I be notified when any of these happen???

- School Messenger is a calling system that will notify you of changes in our school day. Please visit our website ([www.watertowncsd.org](http://www.watertowncsd.org)), under Home to get more information about School Messenger. (In order to receive text messages: text "yes" or "Y" to 67587.) The school office can manage which of your phones get the calls and text messages. School Messenger and the Watertown Website are the fastest, most accurate tools available for your use.
- If you don't have access to a cell/home phone, always keep updated by the TV, radio, website or a friend who can notify you of changes to our regular schedule.
